Key note address:

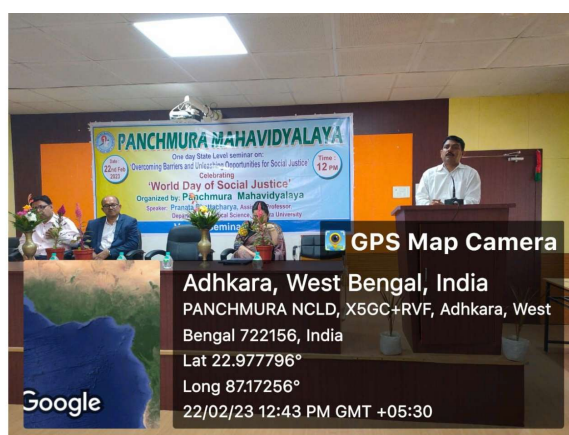

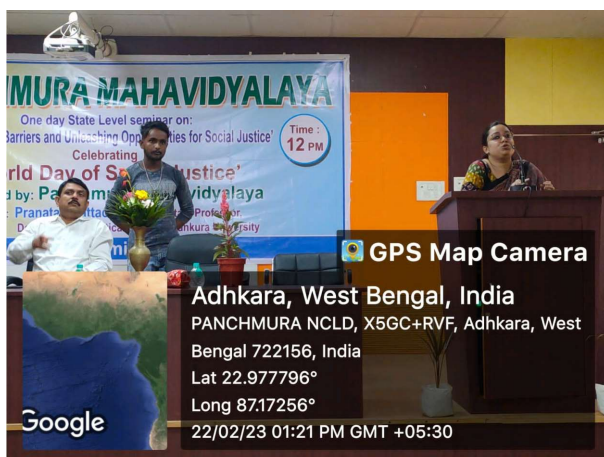

Outcome of the seminar:


- Raised the awareness about the fairness, equality, and respect for all individuals within a
